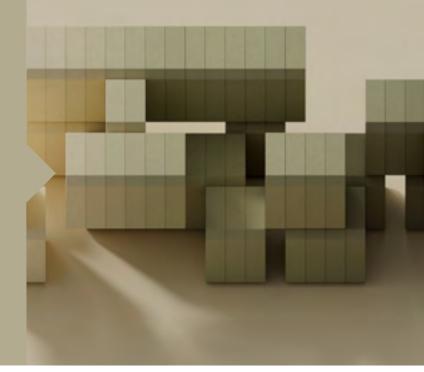
Effective supplier onboarding is essential for maximizing the advantages of Purchase-to-Pay (P2P) and Accounts Payable (AP) initiatives.

How to run a successful onboarding project



Drawing from our extensive experience in electronic data interchange and supplier onboarding, we have identified key criteria essential for successfully integrating your supply chain. Based on this, we recommend that you prepare for the following prior to the onboarding project:

Supplier master data

Make sure that the information you have about your suppliers is updated. High quality supplier data is essential to avoid delays or errors in the onboarding process.

Stakeholder commitment

Get your internal stakeholders onboard, and make sure that the relevant departments and people are up to date on the process. Management commitment, shared goals and organizational understanding are vital for a successful project. Logiq can also provide internal education on the onboarding process for a joint understanding.

Single point of contact

Assign an internal project manager, dedicated to the onboarding project, to keep communication effective.

Clear messaging

To optimise your P2P or AP initiative, communicate clearly that you will no longer accept paper or PDF submissions from suppliers.

Shared goals

Set a long-term shared goal for what you expect to achieve with the project, and measure (and celebrate) success accordingly.

Onboarding step-by-step

To illustrate what you can expect from an onboarding project, we have exemplified a typical project below:

Pre-onboarding

- 1. You submit your existing supplier data through the Onboarding Portal
- 2. Logiq will process, analyze, and segment the supplier data to prepare for onboarding
- 3. Together, we will prepare and customize the supplier communication and landing page
- Based on the supplier data, we agree on a priority of which suppliers to onboard first – and ensure that all the data is correct. We verify the supplier communication and agree upon a start- and end date for the project
- 5. We conduct joint internal education on the supplier onboarding portal and the onboarding process

Onboarding

- 1. A dedicated onboarding specialist will contact your suppliers by email with the information agreed upon in the pre-onboarding phase
- 2. Suppliers will be followed up by email and phone regularly
- 3. Logiq will provide weekly status updates on the progress of the project
- 4. You can follow the project through dynamic reporting in the Onboarding Portal to have a status on the project at any time.

Post-onboarding

- 1. After the onboarding project is completed, a meeting is set up to review the results
- 2. If you wish, we can set a scope for a new onboarding project with other suppliers not included in previous projects
